

GREEN INITIATIVES

Alderbrook Resort & Spa is committed to preserving the natural beauty that surrounds the Resort through sustainable, eco-friendly initiatives. Alderbrook's eco-friendly practices are constantly evolving to keep guests and the environment top of mind.

CHARGING STATIONS: Tesla Motors and universal electric vehicle charging stations are installed at the Resort.

BEACHES: the Resort adheres to beach management responsibility and sustainability to ensure the health of shellfish and preservation of the Hood Canal ecosystem.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT: the Resort boasts its own waste-water removal plant, which received the Outstanding Waste Water Treatment Award from the Washington State Department of Ecology.

IN-ROOM AMENITIES: the Resort provides the luxurious and all-natural Molton Brown bath amenities in bulk dispensers to reduce excessive waste of sample size bottles.

RENOVATION: during the 2002 renovation, the Resort revitalized the stream that runs through the property as a local salmon habitat. Resting pools running throughout the property have been carefully preserved and approved by the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife to encourage annual salmon spawning.

CULTURE OF RECYCLING: the Resort is committed to cultivating a strong recycling culture. Paper, cardboard, plastic and glass are recycled from all areas of the property, including the resort offices, meeting spaces, food and beverage outlets and guestrooms. Recycle bins are also found in each guestroom.

VOLUNTARY TOWEL/LINEN SERVICE: the Resort offers a voluntary towel/linen service. Linens are only changed every third day unless requested to be changed sooner. Towels hung on racks are not replaced, unless specifically requested.

SALES COLLATERAL: the Resort uses a completely electronic sales kit, which includes electronic proposal capabilities and a dynamic and informative website with virtual tours of the property to minimize the need for single use marketing collateral.

GREEN SEAL-RECOGNIZED HOUSEKEEPING CHEMICALS: the Resort utilizes environmentally friendly cleaning products. The hotel seeks products made with less energy and fewer materials while providing a clean, welcoming stay. These products:

- are sold in bulk to reduce the amount of packaging;
- are made with recycled materials, and use renewable resources and not fossil fuels;
- have extended durability and reuse potential;
- contain no toxins or toxic chemicals.
